Family, friends, and the community all came together in their winter white cocktail attire to make an impact in both awareness about and research regarding CF. Cystic Fibrosis is a disease that affects the lungs, pancreas, and other organs, and leads to life-threatening lung infections. 30,000 children and young adults are living with the degenerating disease, and at the moment, there is no cure. Stanley's family has been working side by side with the CF Foundation since his birth 13 years ago (he is the poster child for the Foundation, and, along with Lonnie Quinn & CBS, plays a key role in its awareness campaign).
